As long as we stay within the confines of the airfield and allow for the safe operations of both aircraft and FPV, this shouldn't be an issue. Proper safety and deconfliction of operation will be necessary.

A new treasurer will be needed and nominees or volunteers will be accepted. If no volunteers or nominees, the BOD will cover for the rest of the year.
